Comprehensive Education

Besides a main campus in Mukono, UCU has two constituent colleges, Bishop Barham University College based in Kabale and Mbale University College in Mbale, in addition to campuses in Kampala and Arua.

If you are not at UCU, you are not at a university.

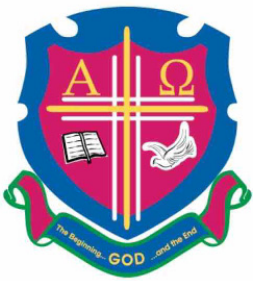

What is the UCU Sunday?

UCU Sunday is an annual day set by the House of Bishops of the Church of Uganda for the Church to come together in support of her Provincial University in prayer, increased awareness, accountability and financial support. The day is observed in all Church of Uganda Churches every last Sunday of September. The second UCU Sunday will be held on September 30th, 2018 under the theme, *Giving Thanks to the Lord...*(Colossians 1:12-14)

How can one support UCU Sunday?

By attending and mobilising people to attend Church services on September 30th, 2018, praying for UCU, and giving financial support in your church that day or directly to UCU. One can also offer to be part of a team of preachers or missionaries who will be visiting different churches that day and subsequent UCU Sundays.

The UCUSoM will admit her first students in August 2018 following the accreditation of our medical programmes by the National Council for Higher Education in March 2018. UCU is very grateful to all its donors in 2017/2018 who have made the vision of The UCU School of Medicine possible. Establishing a school of medicine is an expensive initiative. The collections for the 2018 UCU Sunday will also go towards funding the laboratories of The UCU School of Medicine.

How can one make their contribution to UCU?

The House of Bishops of the Church of Uganda resolved that the UCU Sunday collection will be given to UCU. In addition, donors are able to donate to UCU on a monthly, quarterly and annual basis.
